EXPLORING FAITH

is a small group based study course. It has been developed to help train and equip both those who simply wish to deepen their discipleship through a better understanding of their faith and those who wish to train for a ministry within the church.

There are two different 'paths' through the course, and the flexibility to develop a programme of training or education that meets your needs at the right level for you. If you are interested in taking part, please talk to your Parish Priest.

Education for Discipleship

Meet in a small group to learn more about the Bible, theology and Christian life and belief.

9 optional modules are offered over 3 years. Each will involve 8 group sessions and a seminar day and will focus on an area of study, such as the Letters of Paul, Christian Worship or The Church and Society.

This route can be taken simply for your own interest and learning, or, by completing reflective assignments for each module, can lead to a Certificate or Diploma in Theology.

Support with study skills will be given to anyone who is interested in gaining a qualification.

Those who begin the course in this way may be able to transfer to Training for Ministry at a later date if they wish.

Training for Ministry - Lay or Ordained

Exploring the possibility of training to be a Reader, Pastor, Youth or Children's Minister, Priest, Deacon or Evangelist?

Train and learn in your local context alongside others training for different ministries or deepening their discipleship.

In addition to the 'Education for Discipleship' modules and assessments, you will also be invited to attend weekend workshops with others from the Diocese and Summer School courses on subjects such as Spirituality, Ministry and Helping Adults to Learn.

Assignments tailored for those with an interest in preaching, pastoral work, evangelism and ministry with young people.

With the support of fellow students and other members of your local Church, gain practical experience of your ministry and reflect upon it.
